Over the holidays, as you can imagine, the garden is going to be a bit more difficult to manage. If you are able to help out, I really need assistance with the following:

 Keeping an eye on the chooks. They have a permanent water supply and a grain feeder that holds about 5 days of grain.

- Looking after a worm farm at your house. Perhaps one of the easiest ways to help out as you only have to feed 1000 mouths once a week with scraps from your kitchen! I will provide instructions and there are four looking for homes. They do need a nice shady position.
- Taking a weekly turn to keep an eye on the weed situation. This is a fantastic opportunity for a family outing! Maybe a bit of water splashed here and there but most beds will be set up on a wonderful timer, currently being organised by the Jettner family.

Don't forget the Farmers' Market is on in Koondrook this Sunday. There will be a variety of seedlings for sale that have been grown and potted on by students.
