## **Swimming**

As you are aware, our intensive swimming program commences on **Monday, 2 December** for all students. In an effort to streamline the lessons and ensure maximum benefit from the time in these classes, we are proposing that students in years 3 to 6 utilise this week's sports time to travel across to the pool in Koondrook, on **Thursday 28 November** for some initial testing. This will allow teachers to allocate students into instructional groups prior to lessons commencing. Students in K-2 will be assessed on the first Monday.

As permission notes have already been distributed, we will use these to also cover swimming on Thursday, unless parents advise the school otherwise. It is important that these forms be returned to school immediately. Pool entry of \$2.50 will need to be brought in for the year 3-6 students on Thursday, unless they have already purchased a family season membership to the Koondrook pool. Bus transport costs will be covered.


#### **Class Awards**
