E-SAFETY EVENT

As part of National Privacy week, students in Years 3 to 6 will participate in a learning session covering being safe and protecting privacy online. This event has been made possible by Aurora College who provide learning opportunities to students in rural and remote areas through virtual classrooms.

Greg Gebhart from the *Office of the eSafety Commissioner* will present a 40- minute guided experience for students and teachers for National Privacy Week, aligned to the theme, *My House My Rules*. The presentation will address the learning across the curriculum capability: Information and Communication Technology.

Celebrating National Privacy Week this session is a call to action for students to keep their online self safe, by creating and updating their personal approach to online safety.



MY HOUSE MY RULES INFO FROM MRS ALEXANDER

Students from Year 3 to 6 took part in a virtual classroom presentation today presented by the Office of the e-Safety Commission as part of National Privacy Week.

Students discussed good digital habits.

Phones and tablets and computers come equipped with lots of privacy and security

features. As a responsible user, it's important to make a habit to use them. How many of these security strategies do you use?

- I use a unique passcode such as a fingerprint to unlock my device
- I have 'find my device' enabled so if I lose my device I can prevent it being used
- I have turned off automatic location sharing
- I make sure software and virus protection on my device is regularly updated
- I ask others what security features they are using.

Students were given tips on how to detect scammers.

- Why should I trust this person?
- Is this a reasonable request?
- Is my information protected?

They also were made aware of how to be safe when using social media.
